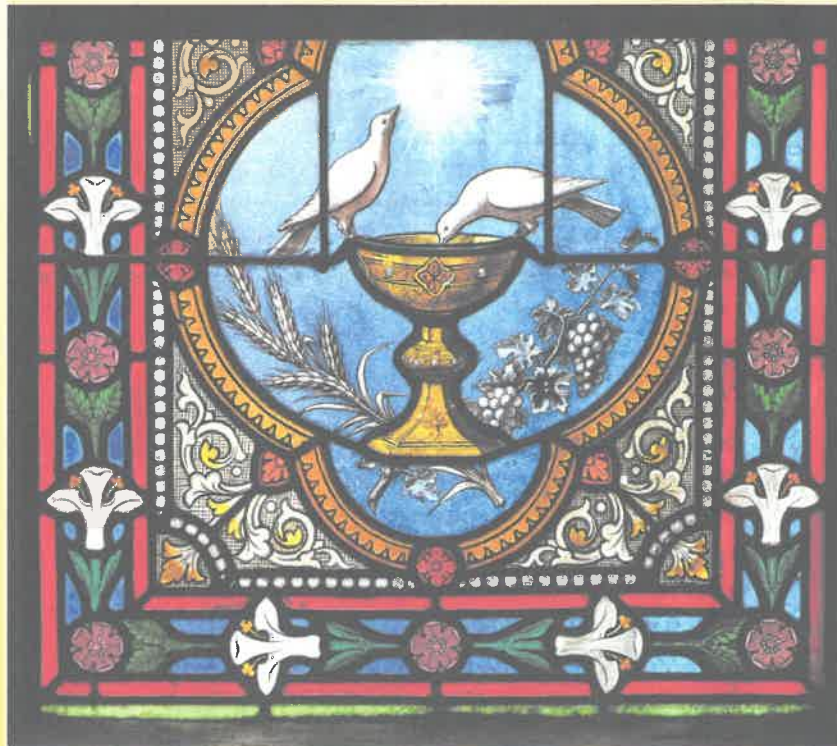

## LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

### Great News!

We have all heard the great news from the Governor that we can now assemble up to a maximum of 25% of the seating capacity stated for our church. Our permitted capacity of 525 allows a total of 130 **people** to assemble at each Mass. This can easily absorb the two weekday Masses.

### Sunday Masses:

Ironically, the “great news” may present a beautiful challenge at some of the Masses on Sunday, especially at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday and at 10:00 a.m. & 12 Noon on Sundays, since those are arguably the best attended Masses. What it implies is that we have to come up with innovative ways to accommodate parishioners and worshippers who would like to “break the Bread” with us, but who may arrive a bit late and wouldn’t find a place among the 25% allowed in the church. It raises the possibility of celebrating Masses in some alternative way so as not to send someone home without the opportunity to worship. Jesus would never turn anybody away, so we certainly will follow His lead to the best of our ability. **However, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains in effect indefinitely.** If for any reason – sickness, body weakness, or any health conditions – and as a result if you don’t feel ready to come to church, please stay home and participate with livestreamed Weekend Masses (currently and will continue at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday and 12 Noon on Sundays).

We are obligated to clean the entire Church after each liturgy, leaving the staff and volunteers with a great challenge of how to accomplish this requirement and complete the job properly. Therefore, we are adjusting Mass times in hopes of providing extra time, and space to complete all jobs thoroughly.

### The Adjusted Sunday Mass Schedule upon Re-opening of Church:

**Saturday Vigil Mass at 4:00 p.m. (combined with 5:30 p.m.)**

**Sunday Masses:**

**8:00 a.m. (combined 7:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. Masses)**

**10:00 a.m.**

**12 Noon**

**5:00 p.m.**

### Other Liturgies:

In addition to Sunday and weekday Masses, we are open to celebrate all other liturgies as well, including weddings, baptisms, funerals, memorial Masses and confessions following the 25% capacity guidelines. Monday evening Novena prayers and Thursday evening Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will take place in the church.

### What are we to do?

All are Welcome back to the Church, which many have missed for almost three months now. However, we are required to observe some basic rules for the health and safety of all which include:

1. All **MUST** wear a face mask (or cloth facial covering) in church. Only the priest celebrant does not wear a mask. Children under the age of 2 are not required to cover their face and **adults unable to wear masks due to breathing problems are asked to remain home for the time being, for their own health.**
2. All **MUST** maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet apart in the church. Only families and those who traveled to church together may sit together. Ushers will be available at Sunday Masses for direction to available pews.
3. The Baptismal font and other fonts are without Holy Water and only the Water dispenser in the chapel area contains water which can be fetched and taken home.
4. **PLEASE**, do not touch or kiss statues and other sacred objects in the church. You can venerate them by simply bowing in front of the statues or quietly and meditatively standing in front of them.
5. The Sign of Peace is still on hold. Instead, we can adopt the Namaste sign of the Indian people (i.e., clapping both hands in front of one’s chest and, bowing slightly to the other person, says “peace be with you”).

May we continue to look forward with joyful hope.....

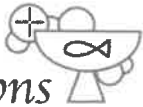
